Literally hundreds of "below the radar" impactful court decisions are issued each year addressing such jurisdictional issues as the circumstances under which nonsignatories may be bound to arbitrate, what constitutes enforceable offers and acceptances of arbitration agreements in an electronic world, and under what circumstances may arbitration clauses be found to be unconscionable. These and several other "under the radar" case law developments are the focus of this presentation.
