They are located in the hotel and the adjacent Villa Auersperg, a city villa from the mid-19th century. From March 2014, on request and at a surcharge air conditioning is available in the rooms of the villa. The rooms have a fan in summer. The internet terminal in the lobby and the videos and DVDs from the movie library can be used free of charge. Bicycles and city maps are provided for guests' use free of charge. The rich breakfast buffet is served from 06:30 to 11:00 and offers a wide range of local, homemade and organic products. In fair weather in summer, you can also have breakfast on the garden terrace. The bar and the café are open from 08:00 to midnight. Yoga lessons are offered every Wednesday morning in the spa area, and relaxation massages are also provided. Both services are available at an additional cost. The reception, the breakfast room, the bar, and the City Spa (with sauna, steam bath, and a beautiful roof terrace) are located in the Hotel Auersperg. All hotel facilities can be used by the guests of Villa Auersperg. The historic Old Town, the Mirabell Gardens, and many restaurants and shops can be reached in a few minutes' walk through the Linzergasse pedestrian zone.

*We start from the hotel and walk to Prague castle, passing through the former Jewish Quarter to the Old Town Square, where you will find St. Nicholas church, the Tyn Cathedral and the Old Town Hall with its astronomical clock and apostles. After arrival at Prague castle your guide will take you on a tour of Prague Castle interior – the Royal Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George's Basilica and Golden Lane, acquainting you with all the important historical details of the Castle. Last stay we will have a chance to have a inside visit of the church of Mondsee which was the wedding church in the Sound of Music movie. Upon arrival into Salzburg check-in at the chosen hotel*

evening transfer to the castle of Salzburg for concert and dinner

*The car will drop us close to the elevator up to the castle. From up there we have a splendid view over the illuminated town of Salzburg. Initially built in 1077, and later enlarged between 1495 and 1519, it became one of the largest fortresses in Europe. Since then the castle's exterior has remained substantially the same. The extension of the castle was commanded by Archbishop Leonhard von Keutschach, as a response to the Hungarian Wars. During that time, above the main entrance a lion holding a beetroot in its paws was added to the castle, and today this lion remains the Castle's symbol. Throughout the long history of Hohensalzburg, the castle was never conquered and remains one of the few castles with this status in Austria. Today the Hohensalzburg castle houses the Fortress Museum. Also the medieval prince apartments are well worth a visit. the dinner is served at the restaurant of the castle and afterwards guests can enjoy a classical concert performing some of the well known masterpieces of W.A.Mozart. After the concert take the funicular railway back to town and transfer back to the hotel.*

**3c.) 15.10.2014 / p.m. half day Schoenbrunn in detail**

Schoenbrunn Palace, the former summer residence of  
the imperial family, is one of Europe's most impressive  
Baroque palace complexes. Emperor Franz Joseph, who  
later married the enchanting Sisi and reigned from 1848  
to 1916, was born here in 1830. The monarch spent his  
last years entirely in the palace, which became the  
property of the new Republic of Austria only two years  
after his death. Today, the palace is part of UNESCO's cultural  
heritage due to its historic importance, its unique grounds and  
its splendid furnishings.



The rooms, shown to the public on guided tours, are mostly decorated in Rococo style. Most of the walls and ceilings are covered with white-lacquered surfaces with ornamentation covered with gold leaf. Bohemian crystal chandeliers and white porcelain tile stoves are also part of the harmonious design. The living quarters and offices used by Emperor Francis Joseph are simple and very unpretentious; by contrast, the state rooms and guestrooms are much more lavish. In 1772, six-year-old child prodigy Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart gave a concert in the Hall of Mirrors. In the Round Chinese Room, Maria Theresa held secret conferences with her Chancellor, Prince Kaunitz. Napoleon met with his generals in the Vieux Laque Room. In the Blue Chinese Salon, Emperor Charles I signed his abdication of the crown in 1918, marking the end of 640 years of Habsburg dominion in Austria and the demise of the monarchy. The Room of Millions, paneled with rosewood and decorated from floor to ceiling with priceless Indian and Persian miniatures, is probably the most magnificent Rococo room anywhere in the world.

After the Grand Tour at Schoenbrunn palace we also have the chance to visit the Horse Carriage museum, besides many splendid carriages of the court one can see many carriages used by empress Sisi, e.g. the coach she rode in as an imperial bride, the charming carriages of her children, the golden Imperial Coach she used at her coronation as queen of Hungary and the impressive black hearse that bore her to her final resting place.

**3e.) 15.10.2014 / p.m. guided tour Augarten porcelain manufacture tour**

In 1718, Claudius Innocentius du Paquier completed a risky mission to bring the closely guarded secret of how to make porcelain to Vienna. In recognition of his achievements, Emperor Karl VI granted him the special privilege of being Vienna's sole porcelain producer. This is how Europe's second porcelain manufactory (the first one was in Meissen) came to be founded in Vienna in the street which is today known as "Porzellangasse".

One could describe the craftsmanship, which works with the mixture of feldspar, quartz and kaolin in its purest form. Each step requires a specialist. Whether it is the mould maker, the model-maker, painter, polisher or gold edger, each of them is a master of his craft. On a tour through the manufactory including our museum our visitors get an illustration of the history of the house, get an explanation of the raw materials for porcelain and get a closer look on the interaction of specialists in the production of our unique products. Our well trained guides explain the production and inform you about the history of the Viennese Porcelain Manufactory. As an add on it is possible to organize a creative tour where one has the possibility to paint his own piece of porcelain tours only possible in english

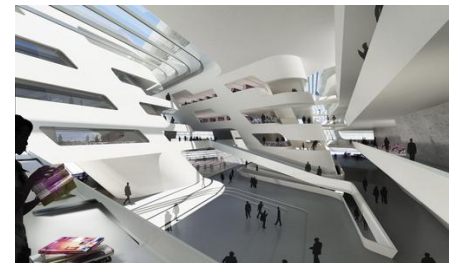

Both as famous as Sigmund Freud or as modest as a shoemaker or homemaker, 140,000 Austrians had to flee the country for "racial reasons"; 65,000 who could not escape were murdered.*
