

The World of Sanctions: How Did We Adjust?

Many industries and markets in the EU, US and other countries were caught by surprise by the scope and impact of the economic and trade sanctions imposed on Russia and Belarus this year. Companies, financial institutions, and third-country governments have had to adapt quickly to the new reality of:

- the broadest multilateral trade restrictions on any country in the world,
- growing restrictions on professional services to parties in Russia,
- multilateral financial sanctions as broad as those imposed on Iran and other embargoed countries,
- escalating restrictions on trade in Russian-origin petroleum, gas, and solid fuels.

In this panel we will discuss how the private and public sectors have adapted to these broad restrictions on trade and have been addressing the indirect impacts on trade with and through other countries. We will flag key issues to be alert for, issues that many companies might be overlooking, and where the sanctions are likely headed next.
