Options

Walk: Saratoga Battlefield has several miles of hiking trails, including its only marked trail, the 4 1/4 mile Wilkinson Trail (a loop trail) - other trails are established, but not marked. Pedestrians may also walk or bike the Driving Tour Road on weekends using the marked Multi-Use Lane.

Drive: Drive Battlefield Tour Road at your own pace. Drive time, without any stops, is about 30 minutes. Drive time with a short stop at each of 10 wayside interpretive stops is around 1½ - 2 hours or using only 4 wayside interpretive stops, takes around 1 hour.
