202.70(c)(6) to clarify the types of insurance coverage cases that will be heard by the Commercial

Division

The NYSBA Commercial & Federal Litigation Section ("ComFed") and its Commercial Insurance Disputes Committee ("CIDC") write in support of the proposed amendments to the Rules of the Commercial Division (22 NYCRR § 202.70) to clarify the types of insurance coverage cases that may be heard by the Commercial Division.

ComFed and its CIDC initially proposed these amendments to the Commercial Division Advisory Council on April 3, 2025, for the reasons set out in Exhibit 2 to the Request for Public Comment. Ambiguities in the current rules have led to confusion about the Commercial Division's jurisdiction over certain complex commercial insurance cases. The proposed amendments resolve those ambiguities and promote the Commercial Division as a leading court for resolving complex commercial insurance disputes. We urge the Chief Administrative Judge and the Administrative Board of the Courts to adopt the proposed amendments as currently proposed.
