Some of Jenny’s successes include:

- Received a decision dismissing class action wage and hour claims against her clients;

- Successfully argued commercial lease issues before the En Banc Pennsylvania Superior Court;



- Received a decision forcing the recusal of an entire Board of Supervisors and their Solicitor regarding any matters that a certain developer brought to that township;
- Successfully defended an appeal of a zoning change, permitting construction of a \$150 million office building on time and preventing the landlord from losing a long-term tenant;
- Forced Wachovia/Wells Fargo to provide permanent financing for a \$70 million shopping center, where there were complex derivative investments and alleged penalties; and
- Successfully defended a frivolous claim and recouped \$175,000 in sanctions to cover the client's attorney fees.
