



## PUBLICATION AGREEMENT FOR SECTION PUBLICATIONS

**The New York State Bar Association (NYSBA) has agreed to consider the publication of your article entitled:**

**Grant of Rights:** In consideration for publication of the Work and the anticipated publicity resulting therefrom, you grant NYSBA the following rights:

The worldwide, irrevocable, and perpetual license and right to: 1. Use for all purposes, in all languages and in any form or media, whether now known or hereafter developed; 2. The exclusive right of first publication of the Work; 3. The right to republish the Work in any form or media, whether now known or hereafter developed; 4. The right to license the rights granted hereunder to third parties, including the right to license the Work for publication or distribution in any form or media, whether now known or hereafter developed; and 5. The right to use your name, likeness, photograph and biographical material in connection with the advertising, publicity or promotion of the Work, including the following release:

Author hereby consents to and permits any and all uses and displays, by NYSBA and its licensees, of the Author's name, voice, likeness, image, portrait, appearance, and biographical information in, on, or in connection with advertising, publicity, and sales promotion of the Work in perpetuity, throughout the world, in any and all media and formats and by any and all technologies and means of delivery whether now or hereafter known or devised for all purposes of NYSBA ("Permitted Uses"); and to the extent permitted by applicable law, Author hereby forever releases and discharges NYSBA, its legal representatives, and assigns from all claims, demands, rights and causes of action of whatever kind or nature arising from and by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen injuries, damages, losses, costs, expenses, and liability of any kind, arising under any legal or equitable theory whatsoever at any time in connection with any Permitted Uses and the consequences thereof resulting from the Permitted Uses, including without limitation, among other things, any and all claims for libel, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, and defamation.

**Use by Author:** Following first publication of the Work by NYSBA you retain all right to use the Work for your own personal and professional use and to promote your employer, law firm, or law practice. This use includes permission to make and distribute print or digital copies of the Work to friends, colleagues, clients, or on your employer or law firm website or social media promoting your law practice without further notice to or approval from NYSBA. Any such copy must contain the following notice "Reprinted with permission from the New York State Bar Association."

**Republication:** If you seek to have the Work republished in another publication, other than is set forth above, you may do so upon prior written notice and approval from NYSBA. Such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld when republication is more than 90 days after the original publication date. Request for approval of republication earlier than 90 days may be requested at any time. All notices and requests for approval shall be sent to the following:

It is recommended that any request for approval be submitted at least 5 business days prior to any republication submission date.

**Editing:** The author authorizes the New York State Bar Association's editorial staff to edit and revise the Work prior to publication. It is understood that any changes related to, for example, grammar, punctuation, and stylistic matters, will be made without the need for author approval. The author will have the opportunity to review any substantive changes after copy editing.

**Warranty:** You warrant that you are the sole author of the Work, that the Work is original with you, that its publication will not infringe on the rights of others, and that you have full power to make this agreement.

**Previous Publication and Permission:** You warrant that the Work has not been published elsewhere in whole or in part (except as may be set out in a rider attached hereto) and that no agreement to publish the Work or any part or version thereof is outstanding. Should the Work contain any material that requires written permission for inclusion in the Work, you represent that you have obtained such permission in writing from the copyright owner.

**Jurisdiction:** This letter contains the entire and complete understanding of the parties and shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York, without reference to conflicts of laws and without regard to its location of execution and performance. Any equitable or civil action arising under this letter shall be heard in the federal or state courts located in Albany County, State of New York and the Author consents to the venue and personal jurisdiction of such courts. This agreement can only be changed by an agreement in writing signed by all parties.
