

Executive Committee Fellowship

The Tax Section of the New York State Bar Association invites law students with an interest in tax who are completing their first year at law schools in New York State to apply for the “Executive Committee Fellowship” (the “Fellowship”), which offers the opportunity to attend the [Tax Section’s 2026 Summer Meeting](#).

The Summer Meeting will be held from Friday, June 12, 2026 to Sunday, June 14, 2026 at the Hilton Arlington Rosslyn The Key. The Hilton is located directly across from Georgetown in Rosslyn, Virginia. The Fellowship covers the cost of registration as well as two nights in the Hilton. Fellows are responsible for incidentals, as well as for their travel expenses.

The Tax Section writes reports about cutting-edge issues in tax, which help the tax authorities improve the tax system by highlighting challenges under current law, commenting on proposed rules, and suggesting reforms to make the system fairer and more efficient. The Tax Section offers its members the opportunity to draw on their expertise to improve the system.

The Fellowship is a way to learn about the work of the Tax Section and to meet our members. Our hope is that attending the meeting will increase your interest in joining the Tax Section after you graduate. Because our goal is to introduce Fellows to the Tax Section’s members and its work, they are expected to attend all of the Summer Meeting’s programs and meals.

This opportunity is limited to first-year students because these funds should be used only for students whose attendance would not otherwise be funded by another institution.
